MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The City of Indianapolis, Division of Homeland Security, is the sponsoring agency of the Marion County RACES.

The requirements for membership are:

- + possessing a valid FCC issued Amateur Radio License
- + be at least 18 years old
- + have completed these six (6) of the National Incident Management System courses
 - ICS-100 Introduction to Incident Command System
 - ICS-200 ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents
 - ICS-300 Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents
 - ICS-400 Advanced ICS for Command and General Staff
 - ICS-700 National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction
 - ICS-800 National Response Framework, An Introduction
- + be a member of NWS Chat
- + must have completed Severe Weather Spotter Training within last two (2) years
- + complete Marion County Background Check Authorization Forms

Copies of your Amateur Radio License and NIMS Course Completion Certificates should accompany your application.
