

# 2018 Indianapolis 500 Parade – Sat 26 May

## 1) ADMINISTRATIVE

- a) **Command / Operations:** 10<sup>th</sup> & Ft Wayne Ave; IFD Fire Headquarters Bldg
- b) **NCS Station:** 11<sup>th</sup> St at Meridian St.
- c) **NO CROSS-BANDING AUTHORIZED UNLESS APPROVED BY COORDINATOR IN ADVANCE**
- d) 8:00am – Pre-event meeting at Tyndall Armory (Coordinator ONLY)
- e) 9:00am - Net Operational
  - i) 443.000 (100PL) Golf Carts (on gutter mount antenna)  
144.990 for APRS on Golf Carts shared w/Golf Cart antenna
  - ii) 443.325 (156.7PL) Medical (on gutter mount antenna)  
224.800 (88.5PL) for PSC Command 220Mhz gutter mount antenna
  - iii) 146.460 Simplex (primary) (on vertical base antenna)  
146.490 Simplex (alternate)
  - iv) Event Radio: **Command Channel**
  - v) Public Safety Communications (PSC) Radio Channels: **S1 – T?**
- f) Ham Radio Volunteer Meeting to be conducted over the internet (email)
- g) 9:00am - Volunteers to be “on location” (except for those designated earlier)
- h) OFFICIAL EVENT – 1.5 hours 12:00pm – 1:30pm
  - i) Ham Radio Volunteers – 9am – 2:30pm
- i) Port-o-lets are at each intersection + in-between in some areas
- j) **No sooner than 15 minutes after Parade End passes should a station be released.**
- k) Main Medical & Hospitals should stay active until 1 hour after end of parade.
- l) Fire Ops Command manned: 8am
- m) Medical personnel on locations: 6am (10am)
  - i) 11 bicycles, 5 golf carts
- n) Medical volunteers at Aid Tents: 9am
- o) Ambulances on locations: 10am
  - i) 6 ambulances
- p) IFD Medical personnel on locations: 11am
  - i) 6 bicycles, 2 golf carts, 2 at Med. Cmd, 2 at Tent #3

## 2) ROUTE

- a) **START LINE** on North and Pennsylvania Streets
- b) South on Pennsylvania to Washington Street
- c) West on Washington Street to Meridian Street
- d) North on Meridian Street, around the Circle, to 11<sup>th</sup> Street – **FINISH LINE**

## 3) LOST CHILD / PERSONS

- a) If a person is declared “lost”, they will be escorted to the nearest First-Aid Tent. Information will be radioed to the NCS referencing lost individual. They will remain there until claimed. If the event is over, this person is escorted to the Tyndall Armory until they are claimed.

- b) IMPD are the “releasing” officials for Lost Children
- c) Methodology: Child found – Escorted to Tent – Ham Radio operator notifies NCS – NCS notifies DPSC & Info Tent (Lost Child Official) – IMPD is only official who can release child to custody of parent/guardian. Notify all when child is released.

#### **4) MEDICAL**

- a) Fire Ops Command dispatches all ambulances
- b) All First-Aid / Medical Tent Hams will log who was treated & who went where.  
Only patients transported to Hospitals or who need a golf cart ride will be called into the NCS.
- c) DPSC Radio will be monitored and medical issues documented
- d) Lost Person channel on Event Radio will be monitored and issues documented
  - i) Lost Person Director is located at 12<sup>th</sup> & Meridian; reports
- e) 12<sup>th</sup> St Medical; 12<sup>th</sup> St & Meridian; west side OPEN at 9am
- f) First-Aid Tents / Lost Persons
  - i) #1: St. Joseph St., between Meridian & Scioto OPEN at 9am
  - ii) #2: St. Clair St., between Meridian & Penn. **OPEN at 6am**
  - iii) #3: Michigan St., between Meridian & Penn. OPEN at 9am
  - iv) #4: New York St., between Meridian & Penn. OPEN at 9am
  - v) #5: NW corner of Monument Circle OPEN at 9am
- g) Ambulances
  - i) #1; Pennsylvania & St. Joseph (east side)
  - ii) #2; Pennsylvania & Michigan (east side)
  - iii) #3; Pennsylvania & Market (east side)
  - iv) #4; Meridian & Ohio (west side)
  - v) #5; Meridian & St. Clair (west side)
  - vi) #6; Meridian & 12<sup>th</sup> (west side)
- h) Medical Carts will be assigned by IEMS
- i) Patient Tracking (see Patient Tracking Sheet)
  - i) Gender (male / female)
  - ii) Person’ Initials
  - iii) Spectator or parade participant
  - iv) Which affiliation (what school or group is this person with)
- j) Hospitals involved
  - i) Eskenazi Emergency Room
  - ii) Methodist Hospital Emergency Room

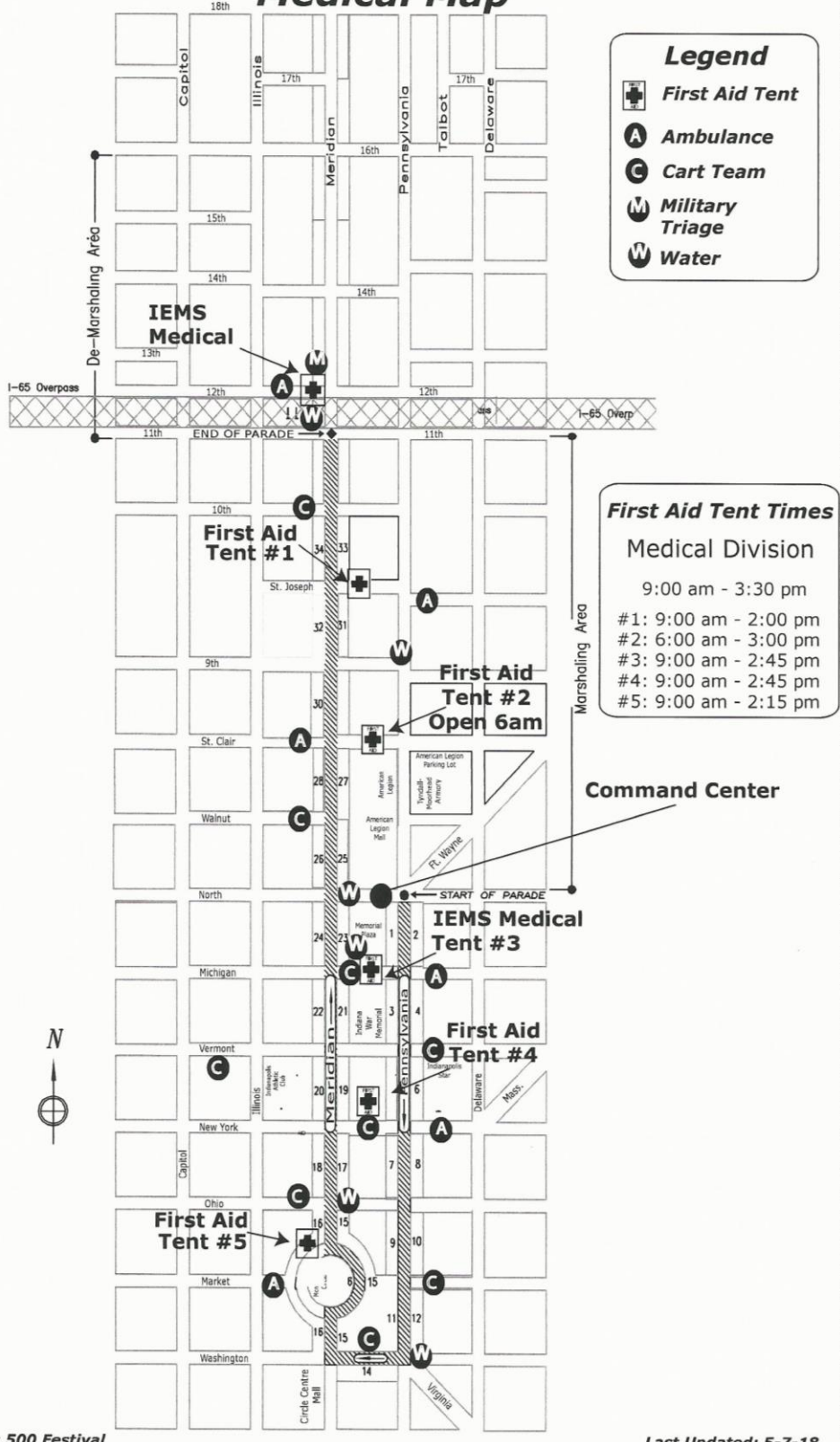
## **5) GOLF CART ESCORTS – using APRS**

- a) Golf Carts will use Illinois St. and/or Delaware for expediency
  - i) #1; Meridian & 12<sup>th</sup> @ 12<sup>th</sup> St Medical Tent
  - ii) #2; St. Clair St., between Meridian & Penn. at Aid Tent #2
  - iii) #3; Michigan St., between Meridian & Penn. at Aid Tent #3
  - iv) #4; New York St., between Meridian & Penn. at Aid Tent #4
  - v) #5; NW corner of Monument Circle at Aid Tent #5
- b) Golf Cart, driven by Ham Radio operators, will be dispatched to deliver “walking wounded” to nearest First-Aid / Medical Tent or to the Med. Tent @ 12<sup>th</sup>/Meridian

- p) V22; Golf Cart 5 – begins at First-Aid Tent #5
- q) V23 / V24; Eskenazi Hospital Emergency Room
- r) V25 / V26; Methodist Hospital Emergency Room
