

ALL VOLUNTEERS: You must know where you are EXACTLY, and what streets are near you

MEDICAL TENT Ham Volunteers (146.460 main frequency) (146.490 – Back-Up)

What to do:

Report arrival to NCS

Record any persons receiving medical attention need to be annotated on the Patient Tracking Form
Record & Report (to NCS) any person requiring transport to a hospital

HOSPITAL EMERGENCY ROOM Volunteer (443.325 – 156.7 PL repeater)

What to do:

Report your arrival to NCS

Record & Report (to NCS) initials, sex, and organization that was **brought in**

Record & Report (to NCS) initials, sex, and organization that was **released**

GOLF CART SHUTTLE Volunteer (443.000 – 100PL repeater) (144.990 – APRS)

What to do:

Report your arrival to NCS

You are driving the carts; so be careful while operating your radios.

Carts are for the transport of non-emergency Parade participants from parade route tents to the 12TH & Meridian tent area. Dispatched from NCS.

Carts are to be located at Medical Tents along route. Use Illinois & Delaware Streets as north-south transport routes.

EVENT RADIO listener

What to do:

Listen / Record any / all calls for medical assistance and/or missing persons.

Listen for any calls for Mike Palmer (notify when called)

PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO listener (S1 – T?)

What to do:

Listen / Record any / all calls for medical assistance and/or missing persons.

Listen for any calls for Mike Palmer, DHS-41 (notify when called)
